<p><i>ALPHABETS (for children entering Kindergarten in September of 2021) - Parent participation is required. Don't have to be potty trained. Learn about how fun the alphabet can be through songs, crafts and games. Kids will practice writing and sounding out the letter of the day and work on a project relating to that letter. Throughout this class, kids will practice their preschool skills (tracing names, drawing, cutting, gluing, building, using math toys, exploring art, and using sensory tables).</i></p>

<p><b>ED 1 (for children entering Kindergarten in September of 2020) - Designed to be child's first preschool experience without parent. Kids begin each day with morning activities, calendar (day of the week and weather), and exercise songs. Kids will focus on a letter of the day (tracing letter), letter worksheet and letter activity. Kids will have time at room centers to engage in art, math, skills (shapes, colors and writing), reading and building blocks.</b></p>

<p><b>ED 2 (for children entering Kindergarten in September of 2019) - This is a three hour class that provides hands on activities, learning centers and circle time. Class begins with a carpet meeting to discuss the calendar (date, count up date, days of the week song, weather and weather song). Classes are centered around monthly themes and activities. Each class session involves a center rotation (learning letters, colors, numbers, and shapes).</b></p>

**Ed 3 - Pre K ((for children entering Kindergarten in September of 2018) - Class prepares children for kindergarten. Class includes arts and crafts, language and writing. Class begins with calendar (saying the date and counting up to the date, singing days of the weeks and months of the year, singing the weather song and tracing individual calendars). Class activities are focus around month themes. Kids will participate in room centers including writing center (alphabet), math center (numbers), skill center (colors and shapes) and reading center.**
